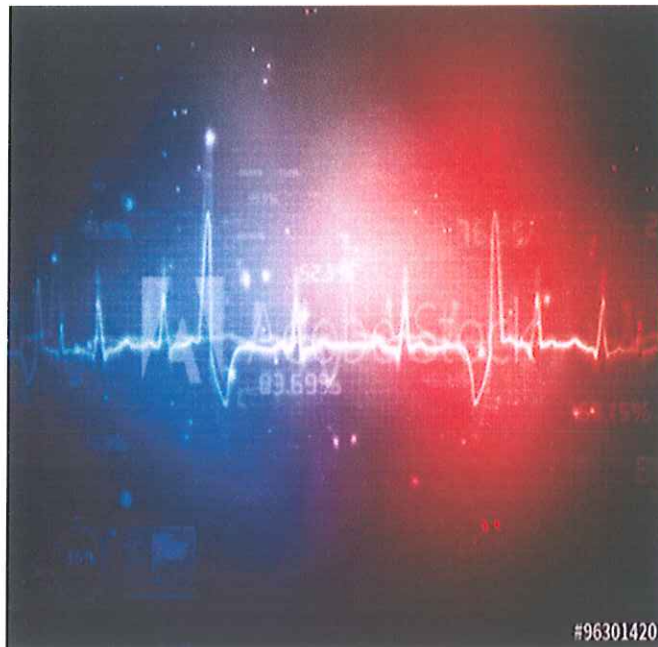
CANCELLATION POLICY:
