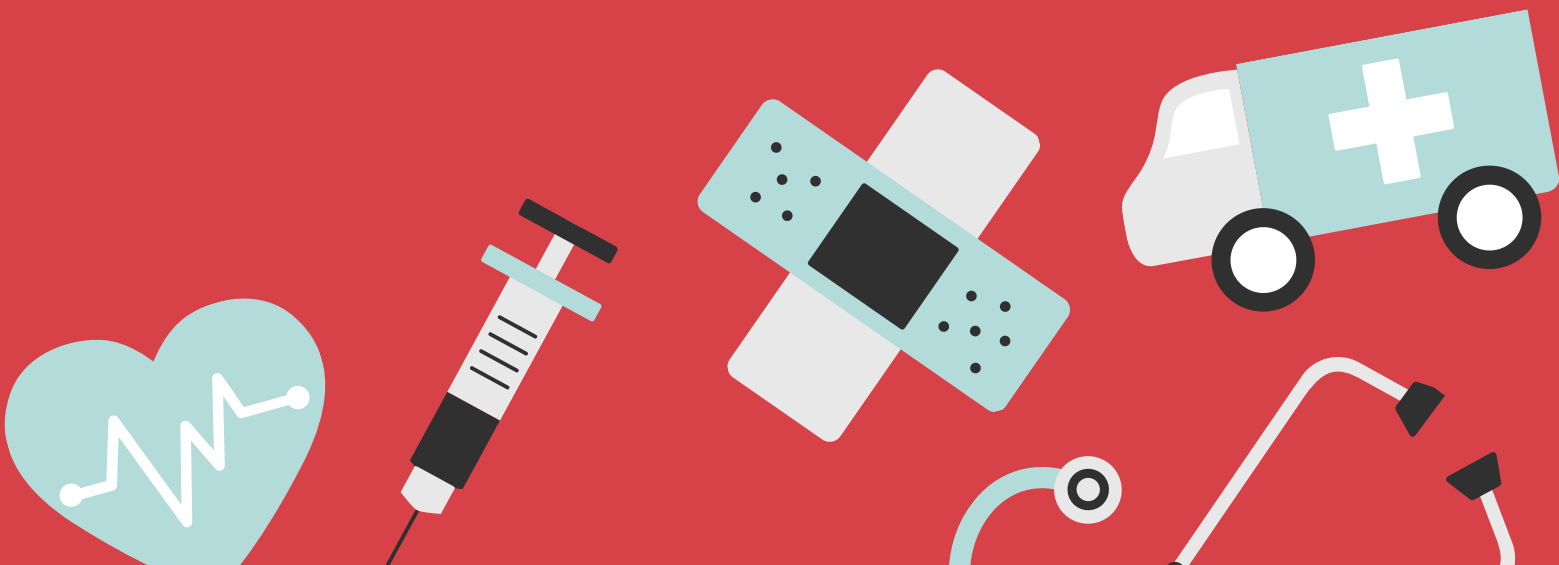

**COURSE DESCRIPTION** - This course is specifically designed for the practicing emergency physician, but may also be of interest to emergency nurses, physician assistants, nurse practitioners and paramedics. This year's speakers are leading authorities on Emergency Medicine topics.
